## Don Warren Community Service Scholarship Information



The Cavalier Alumni Association is proud to announce the Don Warren Community Service Scholarship.

Donald W. Warren began The Cavaliers in 1948 to serve local youth in Logan Square, Chicago. To honor the roots of this organization and continue his legacy into the future, The Don Warren Community Service Scholarship will award one or more marching member of Drum Corps International (DCI) who has exhibited remarkable community service beyond their drum corps involvement.

Members of all World and Open Class units participating in the Drum Corps International Summer Tour are invited to submit **with Director's endorsement signature.** A committee consisting of members of the Cavaliers Alumni Association Board of Directors will review these applications and select a student who epitomizes Mr. Warren's selflessness and desire to help others.

Applications for 2024 Scholarships must be submitted to DCI via e-mail attachment to Scholarships@DCI.org, <u>NO LATER THAN March 15, 2024.</u> Please mark Don Warren Scholarship in the subject line. All required paperwork must accompany the Scholarship Application.

DCI will administrate the scholarship and has established the following guidelines:

- 1. The recipient must be enrolled in an accredited college or university (not a trade school or vocational school).
- 2. The recipient must be an active marching member of a unit who will compete in the 2024 DCI Summer Tour.
- 3. Each nominee must have their corps' director sign off as an endorser.
- 4. Scholarship(s) granted will be paid by check written to his/her university. Scholarship money may be used by the student for tuition, books, and room/board. Any unused scholarship monies, either from the student leaving the education establishment before completing his/her degree or upon the student completing and receiving his/her degree, will be returned to DCI.
- 5. Scholarships granted will not be less than \$1500.00 per recipient.
- 6. The scholarship will be granted for one year only, but recipients may re-apply the next year if he/she remains active with a corps and meets all the other requirements.
- 7. Selections will be made by a committee consisting of individuals from The Cavalier Alumni Association Board of Directors, whose decisions will be final.
- 8. The award will be announced on the Drum Corps International website in late May with other award recipients. Recipients should work with corps director to set up a meeting with the scholarship family/foundation at some point on tour and return a photo for posting at DCI World Championships in August.
- 9. Applications for 2024 Scholarships must be submitted to DCI via an email with ONE attachment (create ONE pdf of all required documents do not send multiple attachments) to Scholarships@DCI.org, NO LATER THAN March 15, 2024. Please mark Don Warren Scholarship in the subject line. All required paperwork must be completed as a part of the Scholarship Application pdf.
